- o A session by Dr Babu Sebastian, former Vice Chancellor MG and Kannur University, helped the senior students to analyse their perspectives and help them take learned choices.

## **Academic Activities**

- o In the academic session of 2023-24, Alfeen embarked on an innovative educational journey under the expert guidance of Hownwhy Education, renowned for its expertise in STEM programs. It offers an immersive journey into the expansive realm of technology, including electronics, IoT, computational thinking, AI, and robotics; strategically aligned with the principles of the National Education Policy, aiming to empower students with a forward-looking skill set that resonates with the demands of the evolving world.
- o As part of Experiential Learning Class 1 visited a joint family with 78 members in Kovappally; Class 2 interacted with the school carpenter and the electrician; Class 3 visited the old age home, Abhaya bhavan, in Palampra. Class 4 was given the experience of a virtual tour to the mountains of Himalayas. Class 6 got hands-on learning experiences in science.
- o We're always up for learning new things... whether it's the latest on politics, sports, technology or some crazy facts, we're ready to test our knowledge. A day in Alfeen begins with newspaper reading for all classes. The first 10 mts of every day is assigned for news reading in association with Manorama Vayanakalari, followed by discussions on current affairs. **Monthly quiz competitions** are conducted by Quiz Whiz Club and class wise winners are announced.
- o LITTLE MATHEMATICIANS & MATH MASTERS club aims at enhancing the logical skills, thereby, inculcating self-study, individual work as well as team spirit. It also helps to create and maintain interest towards Mathematics through various class wise and inter class Quiz competitions.
- O All the students of class VIII to X appeared for level 1 of **Aryabhatta Ganit Challenge** conducted by CBSE. The top three students, Risvani Alif of IX, and Pranav J Nair & Neha Fathima Shiju from Class VIII went to Level 2 which was a national level online test.
- o The students of Class VI to X got an exciting opportunity to review their reading comprehension and critical thinking skills by participating in the **CBSE Reading Challenge**.

#### **SPORTS & PERFORMING ARTS**
