Academic excellence

Academic excellence defines a great institution, and this year's Class XII board results are truly commendable. The school topper is Thara Regi, with an outstanding 97.8%. Three students-Thara Regi, Naina Finy, and Salwa Mol - achieved Full A1, making the school proud. In the Science stream, the toppers are Naina Finy and Rimisha Mariam Rony, while Thara Regi leads in Commerce, and Abienav Sajju tops Humanities.

In the SSE 2024 results, Haizel John emerged as the school topper with 96.4%. Six students - Haizel John, Ahana Anish, Tiya Regi, Firos Ajas Kallumkal, Liya Antony, and Zaina K Shahul - scored above 90%, a testament to their hard work and dedication.

- **Class Picnics** –

In June, Classes X and XII embarked on an enriching educational journey to Mysore and Bengaluru. Highlights included exploring the grandeur of Mysore Palace and delving into innovation at the Visvesvaraya Industrial & Technological Museum, fostering curiosity and learning.

Health check-ups & orientation

- Daily personal hygiene checks are conducted by class teachers, with a detailed monthly inspection by the Health & Wellness Committee. Reports are submitted to the principal monthly. The committee also ensures the cleanliness of classrooms, corridors, toilets, and the canteen, with weekly reports sent to the administrator.
- Vision screening tests for students and teachers were organized by Alen & Harbour Eye Clinic on 24th and 25th July 2024.
- Counselling sessions are regularly conducted by the School Counsellor to support students' well-being.
- Height and weight measurements of students are recorded twice annually for health tracking.
- The Family Health Centre, Edakkunnam provided TD vaccines for children aged 10 and 15, distributed iron and folic acid supplements on 14th October, and conducted an awareness session with the supply of Albendazole tablets on 26th November.

Academic Activities

○ LITTLE MATHEMATICIANS

The Mathematics Department conducted monthly quizzes for classes 1 to 12, from June to November as part of its effort to enhance students' problem-solving skills and foster a competitive spirit. All grades demonstrated excellent performance, with several students solving complex problems accurately. The monthly quizzes have successfully motivated students to excel in the subject.

- All the students of class VIII to X appeared for level 1 of **Aryabhatta Ganit Challenge** conducted by CBSE.
- The students of Class VI to X got an exciting opportunity to review their reading comprehension and critical thinking skills by participating in the **CBSE Reading Challenge**.
- The English Department successfully conducted **Spellathon 2024** from July to November, featuring monthly dictations based on word lists provided at the start of each month. Class-wise winners have been selected and will be honoured during the Annual Day celebrations.

Meanwhile, the **Smart Spelling Bee Competition** offered an exciting platform for students from KG to Class XII to showcase their spelling prowess in a supportive environment. Designed to advance through school, interschool, district, and state levels, the competition fostered healthy competition and language development. Out of 80 registered students, 60 qualified for the interschool level following the initial round on 27th September. Class-wise toppers were awarded medals and certificates, encouraging excellence and boosting students' confidence.

SPORTS & PERFORMING ARTS

- we provide coaching for a diverse range of sports activities including swimming and skating. Zumba and boxing were introduced this year to inspire the students to embrace a healthy workout.
- We also offer training in various performing arts such as instrument music, and western and classical dance forms.

INTER SCHOOL COMPETITIONS

Winners of the first and second places from annual art and literary competitions earned the prestigious opportunity to represent our school at the **district-level art and literary competition, Bhavasudha**. The off-stage events were held at Georgian Public School, Puthuppally, while Baker Vidyapeeth, Kottayam, was the venue for the on-stage competitions. Alfeen Public School stood out with 67 participants who collectively won numerous awards. A notable highlight was the recognition of Shivani Deepu as Kalathilakam in Category 3-a proud moment that underscored the extraordinary talent in our midst.

- Alfeen Public School hosted the Central Sahodaya Conclave Kottayam Interschool District Swimming Championship 2024 on 29th November, with three participating schools: Life Valley International School, Puthuppally, Sree Kumaramangalam Public School, Kumarakom, and Alfeen Public School. We won the championship along with three individual titles: Leo S. John (Under-19 Boys), Afrin Shah Shahmon (Under-11 Boys), and Mizba Maryam (Under-11 Girls).
- Our students excelled in the Inter-School Digital Fest 2024: Ruben Tinu (Class VII) secured first place in Category I Tech Talk, while Melwin Pious and Aravind Prakash took second in Category II Robotics.
- Class XII students Melwin Pious and Aravind Prakash participated in the Young Innovators Program 6.0, a flagship Government of Kerala initiative, with their project Smart Plant Water Irrigation System, also submitted to the ATL Marathon 2023-24, where it was recognized among the top 500 teams in India.

Special Achievements & Training Sessions

A four-day training workshop for teachers DISHARI was conducted by Resorcio CBSE Plus in May, a unique comprehensive initiative aimed at improving school education by providing resource, training and monitoring to students, teachers and parents.
